1. Additional Fees *(not included in package price)*

Standard Tips & Gratuities	\$113 per person <i>(billed & paid separately)¹</i>
El Al taxes & fuel surcharges	\$299 per person <i>(Current rate as of February 2009)</i>

Airline taxes and fuel surcharges are subject to increase without advance notice by the airlines, until the date that tickets are actually issued. We can ticket after we receive full payment from ALL trip participants. *The charge for taxes and fuel surcharges will be added to your final bill **at the rate known at that time**. Should these fees increase between the final billing and actual ticketing, we will send you a supplemental bill for the increase.*

2. Options

- For “Land Only” please deduct \$1450. *Do not add the airfare tax and fuel surcharges*
- Single Occupancy hotel accommodations: Add: \$655
- For a child (aged 2 – 17) as 3rd in a room: Deduct \$501
- For an adult as 3rd in a room: Deduct \$250
- Quad discount (two adults + 2 children to age 13 in one room in Safed and in Ein Bokek): Deduct \$307 per family

3. Deposit & Payment Schedule

April 6, 2009	Deposit of \$500 per participant (applied to total payment)
June 25, 2009	50% of total trip cost
September 1, 2009	Payment due in full (plus airfare surcharge and tips)

4. Refund Schedule

Cancellation after April 6, 2009	Full refund less \$100 per person
Cancellation after June 25, 2009	Full refund less \$500 per person
Cancellation after September 1, 2009	Full refund less \$2500 per person
Cancellation after December 9, 2009	No Refund

Participants who register for the full land and air package have until September 1, 2009 to change to “land only” with no penalty. Flight changes or cancellations requested after September 1, 2009 will incur significant penalties including possibly the entire cost of the ticket.
